Please be aware:

- The Artist/Film Treatment statements and instructor approvals are **due Feb. 16** per application.
- A keyboard will be available for auditions. A concert piano will be available for rehearsal and performance at the Bell Cultural Event Center. Accompanists must attend the audition.
- Performers are responsible for any special props needed, and performance auditions are limited to eight (8) minutes including stage entry, exit and critique. Judges may shorten an audition as needed to accommodate all entrants.
